We did have a nice spring. Driving through the Vineyards, I see people out cutting grass and doing a lot of watering. We are sure turning up the green.



Because it has been some time since you used your keycard, you may need to hold the card flush to the glass on the front door on the lighted reader (bottom left corner of the door left-hand door) to "refresh" your key card. Rules:

- 1. Entry and exit will occur through the Clubhouse via keyless entry.
- 2. If you are already on the pool deck before 5:30, you WILL HAVE TO EXIT the pool gates so that the guards can lock up. You may then enter the Clubhouse through the front. Your keycard will gain you access through the front door and, when it is time to leave, you will use your key card on the back door as well.
- You MUST be off the pool deck by 10pm or the back door will trigger the alarm system.
- 4. Use the clubhouse restroom if needed and please be sure to clean up after yourself.




