
As I mentioned, not a lot of happening.

Homeowner Concerns or Reports:

- Sarah is stepping down from being a board representative.
- The treadmill needs to be replaced. We will be looking into different options ASAP.
- The sidewalk square that was vandalized last year still has a visible expletive. We are considering different ways to remedy this, such as potentially trying to grind it out.

Clubhouse:

More quotes to redo the bathroom floors are being collected.

Social Update:

- The Food Pantry had a huge pickup! We are still collecting for them throughout the year.
- Toys for Tots was a big success. We filled two boxes.
- Christmas Decoration Takedown is this Saturday, the 16^{th,} from 10am-12pm.

Pool News:

- We still need to get on the schedule for the coping stones and the liquid chlorine installation.
- More quotes for the bathroom privacy fence are being collected.

Grounds:

- The clubhouse sign is still in the works.
- We will be calling about the parking lot repaving and potential expansion.
- Bob spray painted the entrance sign letters white so they all match –Thank you!

Income

- 1. Collected assessments over the plan by \$3,460 due to better than normal collection on past due.
- 2. Clubhouse rental way below plan due to Covid.
- 3. Other Income below plan off Workers Comp review.

Expenses

- 1. City and Village Collection Fees over plan due to increased collections.
- 2. The tax estimate for 2020 was off, resulting in unanticipated expenses.
- 3. Payroll items (payroll, payroll processing, and taxes) ahead of budget by \$3,553.
- 4. Water over budget, possibly due to leaking sprinkler. Partially due to unplanned refill of the pool.
- 5. Pool equipment slightly overdue to equipment issues (motor/wiring).
- 6. Pool repairs overdue to more than expected repairs (chairs/pool gate/urinal).
- 7. Pool Misc over due to unexpected Covid supplies provided by VHOA.
- 8. Pool service contract under budget due to payroll savings (offset extra Covid supplies provided by ProPool).
- 9. Insurance over budget by \$1,492. Was shopping and will be shopped further in 2021.
- 10. Grounds over budget are largely driven by tree removal.

Overall, we finished 2020 \$16,923 ahead of budgeted expenses.

We ask that you visit the <u>vineyardsclubhouse.com</u> website to book your time slot and that you stick to your allotted time. We cannot guarantee that the facility has been cleaned prior to your use, so plan on bringing your disinfecting supplies to clean before and after your visit. Because it has been some time since you used your keycard, you may need to hold the card flush to the glass on the front door on the lighted reader (bottom left corner of the door left-hand door) to "refresh" your key card. - 3. Wipe down before and after use with disinfectant. Bring your own.

WANT TO HAVE A PARTY? HERE IS ALL YOU NEED TO DO

As early as 3 months in advance, you ay book your party.

- 1. You pick a date
- 2. You sign a contract
- 3. You write three checks, due at signing of contract.

1st one is for rental. (\$75) (not refundable within 30 days of date) 2nd one is for the cleaning deposit that's (\$100), (Totally refundable) 3rd one is for the alarm deposit that's (\$100), (totally refundable)

(ALL CHECKS MADE OUT TO VHOA)



IF YOUR KEY CARD IS NOT WORKING

- Good chance it just needs an update.
- Look to the door on the left. Now look above the picture of the dog.
 There is a black rectangle up against the window. Hold your key card flat against the window until it flashes.
- If that doesn't work, call or email the office about getting a replacement.
