Homeowner Concerns:

- A homeowner was concerned about some dead trees in surrounding yards, wanting to clarify who was responsible for taking care of these trees. When this happens. It is, in fact, the homeowner's responsibility to clear or to have the trees cleared.
- Other homeowners have remarked to the new writer for the Grapevine, Bob Isermann; that they would like to see the rules posted in the Grapevine regularly, regarding our pets as a reminder of "How to be Good Pet Parents" they can't do it for themselves.
- A question about amending the Indentures was brought up. A significant number of homes would have to approve of the amendment.
- There was mention of a playground for small children in the common grounds. It was suggested that the homeowner do some research on the type of project they were thinking of and if they are interested in putting together a proposal to be considered by the board, we would be open to reviewing it.

Clubhouse Review:

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
